**Please tell me what inspired you to create your business and website or how it came to be and also your additional role as Quest Facilitator?**

*I've been a business consultant working in the field of workforce development and project manager for some years, however, my business is Mindset Coaching now. I love technology and love to resource and empower other coaches to get their voice out there too, so that is how I came to facilitate Quest of a Thousand Voices. It's a side activity that I do for other coaches because I have the technology and love to see a new coach's ideas, offerings, voice get stronger and more clarified as they deliver live online webinar. My vision for the Quest of a Thousand Voices is to have 1000 webinar, available to the public each year with messages designed to life the consciousness of the world. Big Picture stuff I know, however we can do it because we have the technology, the passion, the people and the need. Our world is really sleepy and we all can do with a wake-up call, or webinar, I believe.*

**What made you become involved in your chosen field or choose what you are doing? What is your story behind it?**

*In 2011, I asked myself the question, “How do I attract clients to my business consulting services?” and so sought the advice of an image consultant. Before spending a small fortune on having someone else advise me on how to “look” on the outside, I woke up to myself! I was seeking how to attract people to me on the inside! I wanted to be even more, on the inside! I found myself in a training room with The Coaching Institute before I really even knew what Life Coaching was! Funny isn't it; lots of others in that room said the same thing! I was drawn there by some kind of internal search and I'm so glad that happened. So now, I still engage in personal and professional development, studying with The Coaching Institute and with my own Coach and Mentor Rachel Anastasi! As I learn I implement and teach so it's a great way to see continuous evolution in myself, my business and my clients.*

*My niche is working with people unhappy in their job and career. There are lots of people asking the question, “What do I want to be when I grow up?” and they are as old as 60! LOL. I find that unhappiness at work is just the tip of the iceberg really. It's all about being happy with self really, but hey, the unhappy campers out there don't really know that yet in many cases! I get the call up from the managers of teams because they have noticed the unhappy campers are spoiling the soup so to speak! In many cases, recruitment agencies or people I know refer individuals to me also. In some cases, it's just to get through an upcoming job interview!*

*I have a passion for breakthrough on a personal level so I also hold events where people get to meet, greet and influence the most powerful person in their life, themselves. That is my passion, really. There is a “chain breaker” in every family you know? A person whose purpose in their family's story is just that; to break the chains of generational sadness and limiting beliefs. Change the world for one person and free generations. That is true of my experience and family and I love to light that lamp where ever I can. I use NLP (you know Neuro Linguistic Programming) and other therapies to do that for people. Just love it.*

**Describe your ideal clients, customers or how the information you have learnt can benefit your clients or other people?**

*Like I said, mid 30's right up to retirement age. People seeking to reinvent themselves or just work out how to be happy in their current role. It's a bit like when relationships start to break down, sometimes "The grass is greener" strategy can get you into a lot of hot water! I have a saying that if the grass looks so green over there, go water your lawn!*

*I do help people discover how they come to be working in the roles they are working and introduce them to the high achiever that they really are, when they get to see what they have accomplished. From that platform, there are many more choices to step up, across and sometimes off the worrisome road from.*

*The career exploration is something that I do with my clients in Victoria through an online program funded by government, so it's not only coaching that is available.*

*In the personal breakthrough aspect of my coaching work, I find it's the same customers really. Like I said, every family has at least one "chain breaker" and they are attracted to me. I don't have to do too much to find them. Higher purpose perhaps!*

**How long have you been involved or owned your business?**

*Since 2009 I've been working in and on my own business doing consultancy work around workforce development; however I've been coaching since 2011. It's such a journey, I'm currently working on refining the webpage and products to match the niche message and I'm writing the online career guidance program at the minute. Ever evolving which is great.*

**What was your ultimate goal when you decided to open your business and has that goal changed?**

*Back in 2009, I was looking to work for myself so I wasn't relying on contracts and employers to dictate what I did, how I did it etc. So my goals has been reached, of course, remember my saying about the green lawn! Well, it's darn hard work, uncertainty around money, image, product, blahdy blah blah!!!! Higher quality problems and with my coaching work, oh my, the reward of sharing the change in people's, generations experience of life is a huge reward.*

**Would you like to share what community events or charities that you support or sponsor or would like to?**

*Well, at the minute, I feel like the Quest of a Thousand Voices is a bit of a charity! Hahaha. It's a service to coaches however the vision is to wake up the world. *I deliver induction training for not for profits to give volunteers a welcoming start to their roles and I would love to encourage everyone to find one way to volunteer (even if it's for half a day a month!). A volunteer at the local botanical gardens here is quoted "You haven't really lived until you have experienced being a volunteer" I agree with that whole heartedly. so that is my shout out, get out there and volunteer.*

**And finally Majella what are your accomplishments or do you have anything that you would like to promote?**

*Well, coaches out there, get over to the face book subscriber page for Quest of a Thousand Voices. That is where I would love to see the world change, through giving a voice to passionate coaches. We are really servants of the new earth. Have you read that book by Eckhart Tolle? A new earth? It's great.*
